

As 2024 comes to a close, we want to take this opportunity to reflect on the exciting updates we've made to DataMine throughout the year.

This year, AASHTO Product Evaluations & Audit Solutions expanded access to DataMine, our online repository, enabling non-State government agencies and Associate AASHTO Members to access data from product evaluations and manufacturing audits. This data supports users in maintaining Approved Product Lists (APL) or Qualified Producers Lists (QPL), comparing product data with laboratory testing results, and exporting data for research purposes.

Due to the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) publishing a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (NPRM) to discontinue its general waiver of Buy America requirements for manufactured products, we introduced a major enhancement to DataMine this year: the Industry Document Repository (IDR). The IDR helps manufacturers meet these new requirements by allowing organizations to easily upload and organize Build America, Buy American (BABA) and Environmental Product Declaration (EPD) documents through our intuitive interface.

Lastly, we launched the DataMine Responsive Interface. This upgrade introduced an inspectorfriendly design, enhancing user navigation and enabling seamless access to the site on tablets. These improvements make it easier for users to work efficiently in the field.

As the AASHTO Product Evaluation & Audit Solutions Technical Service Program expands operations, opportunities are recognized to secure data through preemptive measures. Through new requirements for test data access at the State User level, DataMine will provide a tailored experience for registered users, while delivering enhanced security to its industry participants. As a reminder, if you are a State User and would like to ensure you have full access to these changes, be sure you are registered in DataMine at: Registration Link

AASHTO looks forward to delivering this upgrade to your user experience in the coming month.


Guardrail / Guiderail (GRL)

High Friction and Thin Overlays (HFTO)



- 2025 test deck was installed in Missouri
 - 4 products were installed
- 2 products for laboratory reevaluation
- Initial reports for 2024 Indiana test deck available in DataMine

Joint Sealants / Crack Sealants (JS/CS)

- 2022 North Dakota Test Deck
 - 3-year evaluation has been completed
 - Final data being reviewed and prepared for release
- 2024 Arkansas Test Deck
 - 1-year data has been collected and released
 - Laboratory testing has been delayed but will begin soon





Portland and Blended Cement (PBC)



- 106 audits performed in the second year of the Program
- Recently added a second AASHTO designated laboratory
- Kansas DOT is now requiring industry participation in the program in 2026
- Illinois DOT is requiring industry participation for both mills and terminals in 2026

 Committee is looking to move forward with adding PVC Fold and Form to work plan






Pavement Marking Materials (PMM)

- In Progress Test Deck Status:
 - 2024 West Virginia Deck 11-month data uploaded in June
 - 2023 Pennsylvania Deck 21-month data being uploaded
 - 2022 Wisconsin Deck 36-month data uploaded in May
- Always looking for states interested in hosting a deck
- Exploring ways to evaluate all standard FHWA colors



Rapid Hardening Concrete Patching Materials (RHCP)



Raised Pavement Markers (RPM)




